

#### Beijing

Representing today's China, Beijing is a city in motion with the drama of history in its streets. The future course of the world reverberates here while magnificently preserved palaces, tombs and temples stand as testaments to the past. Stroll through the high-walled "Forbidden City" where, in earlier times, only members of the Emperor's family were permitted.

Visit Tiananmen Square, the largest public plaza in the world, capable of holding one million people and the site
where Mao Zedong raised
the flag of the People's

Republic. The Square is visited by Chinese from all over the country and is surrounded by a variety of imposing buildings such as the Museum of Chinese History, the Chinese Revolution Museum and the Great Hall of the People where visiting Heads of State are entertained.

Wander leisurely through

the grounds of the Summer Palace, residence of the last Empress where she built an imposing Marble Barge. Near Beljing, is the extraordinary 4,000 mile long Great Wall of China, an impenetrable barrier that seems

to go on forever and that protected China

from invading Mongols for over three centuries. A short drive away, through a peaceful valley, are the 13 tombs of the Ming Dynasty. These impressive burial places are actually huge underground palaces with numerous halls built for the Emperors' lavish treasures.

This present day capital of China stands as a bridge from the past to the future.

#### Xi'an

Mirroring everywhere the ancient Middle Kingdom's grandiose style, Xi'an served as the capital of China for eleven dynasties.

Marco Polo visited Xi'an during the Middle Ages when it was considered one of the largest cities in the world. The ancient Silk Road started here and extended to the Mediterranean. Among the 140 places of historical interest and cenic spots, Xi'an is best known for the legendary army of 7,000 life size terracotta warriors and their horses that have stood guard

over the first Chinese Emperor, Qin Shi Huang's tomb for 2,000 years. Known as the Eighth Wonder of the World, this underground ruin was accidentally discovered by farmers in 1974 and presents a unique opportunity to view archeologists at work excavating this huge tomb of Emperor Qin, builder of the Great Wall.

The Great Wild Goose Pagoda, in the center of a working Buddhist Temple, is a masterpiece of classical Chinese architecture.

With its 12 million people, Shanghai is the largest city in all of Asia and has long been considered the commercial heart of China - from the flamboyant and flagrant 1920s and 1930s to the productivity and prosperity of today. Along the "Bund", or riverside boulevard, are grand colonial European-style buildings, a stones throw from the old Chinese Quarter with its maze of meandering alleys.


Window shopping on the Nanjing Road is most rewarding but in case you get tired of shopping, Shanghai




