

Maddox sees red over Goodwill Games

Former Georgia Gov. **Lester Maddox** had some bitter words yesterday for television entrepreneur **Ted Turner**, who initiated the Goodwill Games in Moscow. Maddox, an arch-segregationist who served one term as governor and boasted about chasing blacks away from his Atlanta fried-chicken restaurant, said Turner is a disgrace to his country and should stay in Moscow. "Ted Turner has been an idol of mine, him being a maverick and all," Maddox said. "I've wished him success and I've watched him and studied him. But now he has hurt me a great deal — he's changed from being an anti-communist and now he gives praise to his commie buddies. Ted Turner may as well consider taking up permanent citizenship, either in Cuba or Moscow."
